The results of the June 14 voting on the five proposed amendments are listed as follows:

Amendment 1 – 172 yes, 88 no

Amendment 2 – 141 yes, 119 no

Amendment 3 – 174 yes, 84 no

Amendment 4 – 147 yes, 112 no

Amendment 5 – 165 yes, 95 no

The period to contest the results of this vote begins immediately and ends at 12:00 noon on Wednesday, June 18, 2008. To contest the results you must follow the procedure outlined in the Election Ordinance and listed below. Written requests may be submitted by mail, fax or hand delivered in a sealed envelope to 881 Little Dee Dr., Pawnee, OK.

Contest of Election Results

In accordance with Section 12, subsection (a) of the Election Ordinance of the Pawnee Nation, “*Any qualified voter of the tribe may at any time before 12:00 noon on the Wednesday immediately following the Saturday election, file with the Chairman of the Election Commission a challenge for the results of the tribal election and request a recount. The request will specify the candidate or position on behalf of which the request is being filed. The request for a recount must be in writing with reason given, signed and must be accompanied by a \$300.00 (Certified Check or Money Order) recount fee. If the requestor is successful in the recount, they will be refunded the amount above the actual costs involved in the recount. If the recount is unsuccessful, the requestor forfeits the full recount fee.*

Upon receipt of the request for recount and the recount fee, the Election Commission will conduct a recount of the votes. No Challenge will be considered that is not made within the time provided for that purpose. Poll watchers are allowed to be present at all recount proceedings.”

In accordance with Section 12, subsection (b) of the Election Ordinance of the Pawnee Nation, “*Any qualified voter of the Pawnee Nation may, at any time before 12:00 noon on the Wednesday immediately following the Saturday election, file with the Chairman of the Election Commission a written and signed protest or challenge concerning any aspect of the election. The Chairman of the Election board will respond no later than 12:00 noon on the*

first Wednesday following the closing of the protest period. All decisions made by the Election Commission on protests are final."

Further, the following timelines are posted for tribal members' information.

- Written requests for recount will be accepted immediately following the posting of the results of the vote.
- No requests for recount will be accepted after 12:00 noon, Wednesday, June 18, 2008.
- The Protest Period begins immediately following the posting of the results of the vote.
- Protest Period ends at 12:00 noon on Wednesday, June 18, 2008.
- Election Commission will respond no later than 12:00 noon on Wednesday, June 25, 2008 to the requestor.






