I. Call to Order & Invocation

Vice-President Darrell Wildcat called the meeting to order at 5:39 P.M. **Ms. M. Angela Thompson** gave the invocation.

Angela Thompson to approve Resolution #17-25 approving the Pawnee Nation request a submission of a grant application to the Administration on Aging for Participation in Title VI Part A-Nutrition; Title VI Part C-Caregiver Support Program and Older Americans Act Section 311-Nutrition Services Incentive Program, seconded by Adrian Spottedhorsechief.

VII. Open Forum

Phammie Littlesun – provided a short update on her recent trip to Nebraska with for putting land into trust. Mentioned material received from meeting with Jolene One Star Deputy Realty Officer, Great Plains Regional Office. The Great Plains Regional Office is the only office that processes fee to trust that is to be used in Aberdeen, South Dakota. Jolene One Star and Regional Director in Yankton would like to attend the meeting scheduled for April with the Pawnee Business Council and County Commissioners. The Great Plains Regional Office offers surveying, appraisal services, and deed of the land for free.

M. Angela Thompson – commented on another reason why there is a need for a Reality Department because if there was a land base in Aberdeen being able to Title 1 funds in Aberdeen area to establish and help fund a Reality Department up there as well. They would have the Pawnee Agency tribal shares and if it was able to be as identified as a reservation for the Pawnee Nation they would have a tribal share in the Aberdeen area which could fund a position up there. They would be able to Title 1 OST appraisal services through a MOU as well as the survey portion. They could also use an ANA grant to establish a reality office and that would provide the base funding for the establishment of that office and then look at the tribal share to sustain it and also look at the tribal budget to supplement it.

Adrian Spottedhorsechief - asked what the criteria would be to claim homelands and the possibility of being able to claim more land.

Phammie Littlesun – stated the criteria for being able to claim it as homeland of the Pawnee Nation. Also she questioned if declaring the land a reservation is to be done first before the paperwork is processed.

M. Angela Thompson – provided that the NEPA is also part of the packet that needs to be processed.

Adrian Spottedhorsechief - talked about conferences attended to find aquaponics. He mentioned that he ran into a Choctaw Company that studies aquaponics from small to big for different tribes. For six thousand they can give you a big set up and colleges have done them through grants. Rider Farms was another one that also did greenhouses too that is out of Beggs, OK. Mentioned opportunity for many things to grow through the difference seasons. Grant opportunity from the First Nations Development Opportunity worth \$30,000.
