RESOLUTION #15-30 FEBRUARY 27, 2015

RESOLUTION

Whereas, The Pawnee Business Council is the supreme governing body of the

Pawnee Nation and is authorized to conduct business on behalf of the Pawnee Nation in accordance with Articles IV, Sections 1 and 2 of the

Pawnee Nation Constitution and By-Laws; and

Whereas, The Pawnee Business Council met in special session on February 27,

2015, at the Building 64 Conference Room, duly authorized, with a

quorum present; and

Whereas, the Pawnee Business Council has identified the need to provide a

substance abuse prevention and outreach services program to the tribe and

other Indians in the Tribal service area; and

Whereas, the substance prevention and outreach services have been provided

previously through a contract with the Indian Health Service for the Tribal

Human Development Services program; and

Whereas, the Pawnee Tribe wishes to renew the contract for the Substance Abuse

Program starting on September 30, 2013.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED the Pawnee Business Council does hereby approve the submission of a proposal to the Department of Health and Human Services, Indian Health Service to contract under P.L. 93-638, Indian Health Services funds and authorized the President, Executive Director and/or the Grants and Contracts Manager to negotiate and execute the contract and any amendments or modifications during the period of the contract.
