RESOLUTION #16-118 NOVEMBER 17, 2016

RESOLUTION

Whereas, The Pawnee Business Council is the supreme governing body of the

Pawnee Nation and is authorized to conduct business on behalf of the Pawnee Nation in accordance with Article IV, Sections 1 and 2 of the

Pawnee Nation Constitution and By-Laws; and

Whereas, The Pawnee Business Council met in special session on November 17,

2016, at the Pawnee Nation Multi-Purpose Building, duly authorized, with

a quorum present; and

Whereas, the Pawnee Business Council enacted the Election Ordinance of the

Pawnee Nation of Oklahoma under the authority delegated by Article IV,

Section 4-1, of the Constitution of the Pawnee Nation of Oklahoma; and

Whereas, the conduct, activities, purpose and intent provided by the Election

Ordinance is to establish procedures for fair elections and to insure the secrecy and sanctity of the ballot, regulations and procedures contained in the Election Ordinance which will be administered by the Election

Commission; and

Whereas, the Pawnee Business Council will appoint the general Election

Commission (Sections 3 and 4 of the Election Ordinance); and

Whereas, Cynthia Butler is appointed to the Alternate position effective

November 17, 2016 with a term ending May 31, 2018

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED the Pawnee Business Council does hereby appoint Cynthia Butler to the Pawnee Nation Election Commission as Alternate effective November 17, 2016 with a term ending May 31, 2018.
