RESOLUTION #16-124 NOVEMBER 17, 2016

RESOLUTION

Whereas, The Pawnee Business Council is the supreme governing body of the

Pawnee Nation and is authorized to conduct business on behalf of the Pawnee Nation in accordance with Article IV, Sections 1 and 2 of the

Pawnee Nation Constitution and By-Laws; and

Whereas, The Pawnee Business Council met in special session on November 17,

2016, at the Pawnee Nation Multi-Purpose Building, duly authorized, with

a quorum present; and

Whereas, the Pawnee Business Council continues to approve the consolidation of

education, employment, training and related programs in providing these flexible services through the integration of such programs to eligible Pawnee Nation members, Alaskan Natives, and American Indians residing

in the Pawnee Nation's service area through Public Law 102-477; and

Whereas, the Division of Workforce Development, under the leadership of the

Office of Indian Services is authorized to award grants to current tribal Public Law 102-477 programs to evolve Job Placement and Training

services in an amount not to exceed twenty-five thousand dollars; and

Whereas, the Pawnee Business Council hereby supports the Pawnee Nation 477 Te

Tu Koo program to apply for twenty-five thousand dollars from the Division of Workforce Development, Office of Indian Services, Bureau of Indian Affairs, Department of Interior, to be used to expand Job Placement and Training services within the Pawnee Nation Public Law 102-477

program.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED the Pawnee Business Council does hereby support submission of the application for twenty-five thousand dollars from the Division of Workforce Development to expand Job Placement and Training services.
