## RESOLUTION

Whereas, The Pawnee Business Council is the supreme governing body of the

Pawnee Nation and is authorized to conduct business on behalf of the Pawnee Nation in accordance with Article IV, Sections 1 and 2 of the

Pawnee Nation Constitution and By-Laws; and

Whereas, The Pawnee Business Council met in special session on July 13, 2016, at

the Pawnee Nation Multi-Purpose Building, duly authorized, with a

quorum present; and

Whereas, the Pawnee Business Council is aware the Bureau of Indian Affairs (BIA),

Southern Plains Office, Branch of Contract Management has appropriated

funds available for the Pawnee Nation, under P.L. 93-638 authority; and

Whereas, the Pawnee Business Council herby notifies the BIA, Branch of Contract

Management their "letter of intent" to cut and remove trees and shrubs; replace a ½ mile portion of old dilapidated, barbed cattle fencing; dispose of fence materials; and build a new five wire fence upon BIA approval of

P.L. 93-638 grant; and

Whereas, the Pawnee Tribal Employment Rights Office (TERO) Director and

Commission will review, negotiate, revise and execute all terms and

conditions of the proposed \$6,394.00.

**NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED** the Pawnee Business Council does hereby authorize the TERO Director and TERO Commission to review, negotiate, revise, and execute all terms and conditions of the proposed \$6,394.00 contract with the BIA under the P.L. 93-638.
