RESOLUTION

- Whereas,** the Pawnee Business Council is the supreme governing body of the Pawnee Nation and is authorized to conduct business on behalf of the Pawnee Nation in accordance with Article IV, Sections 1 and 2 of the Pawnee Nation Constitution and By-Laws; and
- Whereas,** the Pawnee Business Council met in special session on September 13, 2016, at the Pawnee Nation Multi-Purpose Building, duly authorized, with a quorum present; and
- Whereas,** the Pawnee Business Council continues to approve the consolidation of education, employment, training and related programs in providing these flexible services through the integration of such programs to eligible Pawnee Nation members, Alaskan Natives, and American Indians residing in the Pawnee Nation's service area; and
- Whereas,** P.L. 102-477, Indian Employment, Training and Related Demonstration Act of 1992; as amended, enables the Pawnee Nation to consolidate the funding received for, but not limited to: Adult Education; Higher Education; Johnson-O'Malley; Workforce Innovation and Opportunity Act (WIOA); Comprehensive Services; Supplemental Youth Services; and Job Placement and Training; and
- Whereas,** the Pawnee Business Council approves the submittal of a three year consolidation plan beginning January 1, 2017 to December 31, 2019 to the U.S. Department of the Interior, Bureau of Indian Affairs (USDOIBIA).


NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED the Pawnee Business Council does hereby authorize the submission of a three-year plan to consolidate employment, training, and related programs through the U.S. Department of the Interior, Bureau of Indian Affairs (USDOIBIA), and hereby authorizes the Pawnee Business Council President or Executive Director to negotiate and execute the grant and any amendments thereof during the period of the plan.


CERTIFICATION
