RESOLUTION

Whereas, The Pawnee Business Council is the supreme governing body of the Pawnee Nation and is authorized to conduct business on behalf of the

Pawnee Nation in accordance with Article IV, Sections 1 and 2 of the

Pawnee Nation Constitution and By-Laws; and

Whereas, The Pawnee Business Council met in special session on June 3, 2017, at

the Pawnee Nation Multi-Purpose Building, duly authorized, with a

quorum present; and

Whereas, the Pawnee Business Council has deemed it necessary and in the best

interest of the Pawnee Nation to establish a Tribal Employment Rights Office (TERO) within the jurisdiction of the Pawnee Nation to enforce

special employment rights on behalf of its members; and

Whereas, the Pawnee Business Council has the power to appoint Commissioners to

the Pawnee Tribal Employment Rights Commission when vacancies

occur; and,

Whereas, the Pawnee Business Council does hereby appoint Christal Windholz to

serve on the Pawnee Nation Tribal Employment Rights Commission effective June 3, 2017, whose term of office will expire December 31,

2020.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Pawnee Business Council does hereby appoint **Christal Windholz** to the Pawnee Nation Tribal Employment Rights Commission effective June 3, 2017, whose term of office will expire December 31, 2020.
