RESOLUTION

- Whereas,** The Pawnee Business Council is the supreme governing body of the Pawnee Nation and is authorized to conduct business on behalf of the Pawnee Nation in accordance with Article IV, Sections 1 and 2 of the Pawnee Nation Constitution and By-Laws; and
- Whereas,** The Pawnee Business Council met in special session on May 8, 2018, at the Pawnee Nation Resource Center, duly authorized, with a quorum present; and
- Whereas,** the Pawnee Nation of Oklahoma is a Federally Recognized Tribe; and
- Whereas,** the Pawnee Nation Department of Transportation and Safety (PN DOTS) has fulfilled the functions and duties of the Secretary of the Interior in accordance with the requirements of 25 CFR part 170 in the planning and development process of the Pawnee Nation Tribal Transportation Improvement Program (PN TTIP); and
- Whereas,** the PN DOTS has developed the Fiscal Year 2018 PN TTIP modification #2 for the Pawnee Business Council approval; and
- Whereas,** the Pawnee Business Council desires to adopt the Fiscal Year 2018 PN TTIP Modification #2 in order to ensure that the short-term transportation needs of the members of the Pawnee Nation are identified; and
- Whereas,** the Pawnee Business Council desires that this Fiscal Year 2018 PN TTIP Modification #2 be forwarded to the Office of Federal Lands Highway as an updated five (5) year forecast of the transportation needs of the Pawnee Nation of Oklahoma.



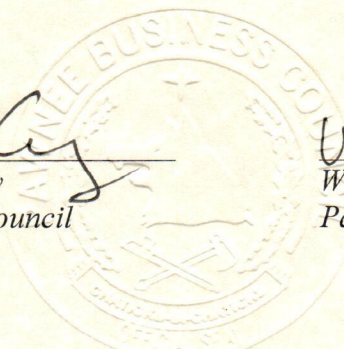
CERTIFICATION


