RESOLUTION

- Whereas,** The Pawnee Business Council is the supreme governing body of the Pawnee Nation and is authorized to conduct business on behalf of the Pawnee Nation in accordance with Article IV, Sections 1 and 2 of the Pawnee Nation Constitution and By-Laws; and
- Whereas,** The Pawnee Business Council met in special session on March 28, 2019, at the Pawnee Nation Resource Center, duly authorized, with a quorum present; and
- Whereas,** the Pawnee Nation Enrollment Committee met on January 15, 2019 to review all relinquishments of tribal members and that the same was submitted to the Nasharo Council at a regular meeting held on March 16, 2019 and was documented by the Nasharo Council by Resolution #19-01 for further review and submission to the Pawnee Business Council for final approval by Pawnee Business Council Resolution; and
- Whereas,** **Debra Sue Howell**, an enrolled member of the Pawnee Nation who has completed and submitted a signed and notarized Conditional Relinquishment to relinquish her membership with the Pawnee Nation of Oklahoma upon acceptance of membership with the Sisseton-Wahpeton Oyate.


NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, the Pawnee Business Council does hereby accept the Conditional Relinquishment of Debra Sue Howell from the Pawnee Nation of Oklahoma and she will be removed from the Pawnee Nation Membership Roll on condition upon being accepted for membership with the Sisseton-Wahpeton Oyate.


CERTIFICATION
