RESOLUTION

the Pawnee Business Council is the supreme governing body of the Whereas, Pawnee Nation and is authorized to conduct business on behalf of the

Pawnee Nation in accordance with Article IV, Sections 1 and 2 of the

Pawnee Nation Constitution and By-Laws; and

the Pawnee Business Council met in special session on September 23, Whereas,

2019, at the Pawnee Nation Roam Chief Event Center, duly authorized,

with a quorum present; and

the Pawnee Nation Constitution Art. IV. §2 reads, 'Subject to the Whereas,

limitations imposed by this Constitution and applicable Federal law, the Pawnee Business Council shall exercise all the inherent, statutory, and treaty powers of the Pawnee Nation of Oklahoma by the enactment of legislation, the transaction of business, and by otherwise speaking or acting on behalf of the Pawnee Nation of Oklahoma on all matters which

the Pawnee Nation of Oklahoma is empowered to act; and

the Pawnee Business Council approves the revision to Chapter 9, Section Whereas,

G, "Bereavement Leave" of the Human Resources Policies and Procedures

Manual; and

the revision will change the number of days allowed for the bereavement Whereas,

leave from three (3) to four (4) days for immediate family members; and

upon approval, a transmittal shall be sent to all Division Directors and Whereas,
