RESOLUTION

- Whereas,** The Pawnee Business Council is the supreme governing body of the Pawnee Nation and is authorized to conduct business on behalf of the Pawnee Nation in accordance with Article IV, Sections 1 and 2 of the Pawnee Nation Constitution and By-Laws; and
- Whereas,** the Pawnee Business Council met in special session on February 1, 2020, at the Pawnee Nation Roam Chief Event Center, duly authorized, with a quorum present; and
- Whereas,** the Pawnee Nation Title VI Elderly Nutrition Program receives funding from the Administration on Aging to provide nutrition and caregiver services to Native American elders in the Pawnee Nation tribal service area; and
- Whereas,** the Pawnee Nation desires to continue the Pawnee Nation Title VI Elderly Nutrition Program to provide congregate and home-delivered meals, nutrition education, health screenings, caregiver services, and other services for Native American elders with assistance from the Administration on Aging; and
- Whereas,** the Pawnee Nation requests the submission of a grant application to the Administration on Aging for participation in Title VI Part A-Nutrition Program; Title VI Part C-Caregiver Support Program and Older Americans Act; Section 311-Nutrition Services Incentive Program (NSIP) to provide Native American elders access to healthy meals and to provide an outlet for elders to socialize with friends and to remain engaged in the community; and
- Whereas,** authorities granted herein shall be continuing unless and until rescinded by separate action of this body.


