RESOLUTION

- Whereas,** the Pawnee Business Council is the supreme governing body of the Pawnee Nation and is authorized to conduct business on behalf of the Pawnee Nation in accordance with Article IV, Sections 1 and 2 of the Pawnee Nation Constitution and By-Laws; and
- Whereas,** the Pawnee Business Council met in special session on February 1, 2020, at the Pawnee Nation Roam Chief Event Center, duly authorized, with a quorum present; and
- Whereas,** the Pawnee Nation Enrollment Committee met on January 8, 2020 to review all relinquishments of tribal members and that the same was submitted to the Nasharo Council at a quarterly meeting held on January 18, 2020 and was documented by the Nasharo Council by Resolution #20-01 for acceptance and further review and submission to the Pawnee Business Council for final approval; and
- Whereas,** **Rebecca Lou Orange**, an enrolled Pawnee Nation member of legal age who has completed and submitted a signed and notarized Conditional Relinquishment to relinquish her membership with the Pawnee Nation of Oklahoma upon acceptance of membership with the Cheyenne and Arapaho Tribe; and


NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, the Pawnee Business Council does hereby accept the Conditional Relinquishment of Rebecca Lou Orange from the Pawnee Nation of Oklahoma and she will be removed from the Pawnee Nation Membership Roll on condition upon being accepted for membership with the Cheyenne and Arapaho Tribe.


CERTIFICATION
