COVID Positive Support Program Policies

Pawnee Tribal members who test positive for the COVID-19 virus are required to quarantine and are unable to go to grocery stores, pharmacies and other places that have necessary items that they need. In order to keep them and the community safe, the PV COVID department will provide them necessary items.

- I. Only Pawnee Nation enrolled tribal members will be eligible to receive services.
- II. An application must be complete to receive services. A completed application means that all required documentation has been turned into the Pawnee Nation COVID department (PNCD). It is the sole responsibility of the applicant to ensure that their application is complete.
- III. All applicants must provide proof of their positive test result.
- IV. PN Covid staff will interview the applicant or otherwise determine their need.
- V. PN COVID staff will purchase items and deliver the items to their place of residence.
- VI. An applicant may receive up to \$250 in items, \$500 if the household size is two or three not to exceed \$1000.00 for a household of five or larger.
- VII. Households will be comprised of those family units that reside in a particular home. Some homes may contain one or more eligible households.
 - A. To be determined a multiple household home, the applicant must submit proof that they are residing with another household by turning in an affidavit signed by the head of the home, the head of the home's rental agreement or proof of home ownership.
 - B. Only family units comprised of an adult(s) and child(ren) or an adult with documented guardianship of an adult may be considered a household within a home.
