## RESOLUTION

- Whereas,** The Pawnee Business Council is the supreme governing body of the Pawnee Nation and is authorized to conduct business on behalf of the Pawnee Nation in accordance with Article IV, Sections 1 and 2 of the Pawnee Nation Constitution and By-Laws; and
- Whereas,** the Pawnee Business Council met in Regular session on August 24, 2021, on Pawnee Nation Microsoft TEAMS, duly authorized, with a quorum present; and
- Whereas,** the Pawnee Nation and its citizen's continue to be disproportionately affected by the COVID-19 Pandemic as evidenced by rising COVID-19 Delta Variant disease rates among our citizen's and broader community; and
- Whereas,** the Pawnee Nation must mitigate this situation to the best of its abilities and the Centers for Disease Control recommends all citizens who test positive be quarantined;
- Whereas,** the Pawnee Business Council, based on the recommendation of the COVID Committee, recommends an appropriation from the PN American Rescue Plan Act Budget in the amount of **\$15,000.00** for the ARPA Quarantine Program; and
- Whereas,** these funds should be automatically transferred to the Pawnee Nation or in the special account set up for allocation.




## CERTIFICATION
