RESOLUTION #21-60 AUGUST 31, 2021

RESOLUTION

Whereas, The Pawnee Business Council is the supreme governing body of the

Pawnee Nation and is authorized to conduct business on behalf of the Pawnee Nation in accordance with Article IV, Sections 1 and 2 of the

Pawnee Nation Constitution and By-Laws; and

Whereas, The Pawnee Business Council met in emergency session on August 31,

2021, on Pawnee Nation Microsoft TEAMs duly authorized, with a

quorum present; and

Whereas, The Pawnee Business Council passed Resolution #04-30 establishing the

Pawnee Nation Academy in August 2004. Subsequently, the school

became known as the Pawnee Nation College ("PNC"); and

Whereas, The National Telecommunications and Information Administration, U.S.

Department of Commerce ("NTIA") is offering a grant opportunity to provide broadband connectivity to Tribal Lands and institutions, and PNC is eligible to apply and receive grant funding under the NTIA Program per Notice of Funding Opportunity Number NTIA-TBC-TBCPO-2021-

2006948; Additionally, PNC is eligible under 4(C)(1); and

Whereas, Promoting broadband adoption and use would benefit the community of

PNC significantly and would be a critical development in enabling PNC to respond to the COVID pandemic and provide opportunities for economic

recovery due to the pandemic; and

Whereas, Through the NTIA Program, PNC qualifies for at least five hundred

thousand dollars (\$500,000) of federal funding that will directly benefit the college and improve access and adoption of broadband; It is the intent and purpose of PNC to apply for funds for Broadband Use and Adoption

only.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED the Pawnee Business Council does hereby approve and support the PNC grant application for Broadband under NTIA-TBC-TBCPO-2021-2006948 and the adoption for its own unique needs and goals.
