RESOLUTION #22-21 MARCH 10, 2022

RESOLUTION

Whereas, The Pawnee Business Council (PBC) is the supreme governing body of

the Pawnee Nation and is authorized to conduct business on behalf of the Pawnee Nation in accordance with Article IV, Sections 1 and 2 of the

Pawnee Nation Constitution and By-Laws; and

Whereas, the PBC met in special session on March 10, 2022, on Pawnee Nation

Microsoft TEAMS, duly authorized, with a quorum present; and

Whereas, the PBC met in a special meeting on November 9, 2021 and approved

Resolution #21-93 to initiate a Constitution Convention to consider

revising the Constitution of the Pawnee Nation of Oklahoma; and

Whereas, the PBC's authority to manage and conduct the Convention has been

delegated to the Pawnee Nation Governing Documents Committee (Committee) to begin in January 2022 and end no later than the end of

March 2022; and

Whereas, due to the Coronavirus Pandemic that has affected a majority of

Committee members, and because the Committee recognizes that additional time is required to complete the work, the Committee is requesting a six (6) month extension to review and propose changes to the

Pawnee Nation Constitution, to be completed in September of 2022; and

Whereas, at the end of the Convention, the Committee will provide interim reports

and present final documents the Council.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED the Pawnee Business Council does hereby approve the requested extension for the Pawnee Nation Constitution Convention managed by the Pawnee Nation Governing Documents Committee to continue its work, and hereby authorizes the extension of the time to add six (6) months to the work period that began in January 2022 and expected to be completed by the end of September 2022.
