**STATUTE #21-03 SEPTEMBER 28, 2021** 

## STATUTE

The Pawnee Business Council is the supreme governing body of the Whereas, Pawnee Nation and is authorized to conduct business on behalf of the

Pawnee Nation in accordance with Article IV, Sections 1 and 2 of the

Pawnee Nation Constitution and By-Laws; and

the Pawnee Business Council met in special session on September 28, Whereas,

2021, on Pawnee Nation Microsoft TEAMS duly authorized, with a

quorum present; and

the Pawnee Nation Tax Commission met in a regular scheduled meeting Whereas,

on April 29, 2021 and has met requirements in accordance with the PN Administrative Procedures Act to conduct a thirty day comment period;

the PN Governing Documents Committee has reviewed with the Whereas,

Commission and is submitting for PBC approval the revision to the PN

General Revenue and Taxation Act, Section 1012, Chapter 10; and

the revision will read as follows: Whereas,

> MILITARY DUTY PERSONNEL SECTION 1012.

All Veterans, with the exception of dishonorable discharged Veterans, shall be entitled to annually register a limit of two (2) motor vehicles at the special rate. All other Veterans' vehicles will be registered at the regular rate. Excise taxes shall be waived on all Veterans' vehicles. Proper proof of military service will be required.

upon approval by a majority vote of the Pawnee Business Council, this Whereas,

revision will be enacted into law.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED the Pawnee Business Council does hereby approve revisions to the Pawnee Nation General Revenue and Taxation Act, Section 1012, Military Duty Personnel.
