CURRENT

ARTICLE XV-SEVERABILITY

If any part of this Constitution is held by the Federal Court to be invalid or contrary to the U.S. Constitution or Federal law, the remainder shall continue to be in full force and effect.

RECOMMENDED

ARTICLE XIV-SEVERABILITY

If any <u>provision part</u> of the <u>Pawnee Nation Constitution shall, in the future, be declared is held by the Federal Court to be invalid or unconstitutional, or in violation of Federal or Pawnee Nation law, it is the intent of the Pawnee Nation that the invalid portion contrary to the U.S. Constitution or Federal law, shall be severed, and the remaining der provisions shall continueremain to be in full force and effect.</u>

PROPOSED REVISION

ARTICLE XIV – SEVERABILITY

If any provision of the Pawnee Nation Constitution shall, in the future, be declared invalid or unconstitutional, or in violation of Federal or Pawnee Nation law, it is the intent of the Pawnee Nation that the invalid portion shall be severed, and the remaining provisions shall remain in full force and effect.
