PAWNEE NATION CAMPGROUNDS AND RV PARK PARK RULES

CHECK IN/OUT AND QUIET TIMES

- Upon arrival guests will check in at the Property office between the hours of 8am -5pm
 Monday thru Friday. Weekend arrivals will need to call the Property Director at (918)399-3124, to make arrangements for RV setup.
- Check in time is at 1pm; Check out time is at 11am.
- Additional fee will be charged for late check-outs and must be approved and paid in advance.
- Any check-out later than 11am will be charged the daily rate.
- Quiet time is between the hours of 10pm and 8am. All noise will be kept at a minimum so as not to disturb your neighbors.

RATE

- The rate is set at \$30.00 US Dollars per night, not to exceed five (5) nights.
- If a guest(s) requires an extended stay, beyond the five night, the Property Director, may at his discretion, approve the request at the current daily rate.

SITES

- All sites are to be kept clean and clutter free.
- Please place all trash in the dumpsters at the entrance to the campgrounds. Household trash ONLY (no outside trash, furniture, animal carcasses, etc.)
- This is a dry camping area. No dumping of gray water or any fluids on the ground.
- No use of generators without approval of management.
- No open fires (grills, fire pits, etc. are allowed.)
- Primitive camping is allowed at \$15.00 US Dollars per night. Not to exceed three (3) nights.

GENERAL

- In case of emergency, call 911 and ask for Pawnee Nation Police and give them the location-Pawnee Nation Campgrounds and site number.
- Children must be supervised at all times.
- Campers are responsible for their guests and their behavior at all times.
- ALCOHOL IS PROHIBITED.
- Any damage to campground facilities will be the responsibility of the guest.
- No vendor activity will be conducted on any site.
- No refunds for unused days or early departures.
- Fireworks are prohibited.
- Firearms are prohibited on any Pawnee Nation property.
- Disorderly conduct, drunkenness, illegal drugs, obscene language, obnoxiousness, disruptive or vulgar behavior will not be tolerated. Any of these actions witnessed should immediately be reported to management.
- Any guest who creates a disturbance or violates any campground rule may be asked to vacate the park immediately. Refunds will not be provided.
- THE PAWNEE NATION IS NOT RESPONSIBLE FOR ANY ACCIDENTS, DAMAGE, OR THEFT ON THE PROPERTY. GUESTS USE THE CAMPGROUNDS AT THEIR OWN RISK.
- The campgrounds are patrolled on a regular basis by the Pawnee Nation Law Enforcement office.
- THE GUEST AGREES TO BE SUBJECT TO THE LAWS OF THE PAWNEE NATION AND THE
 JURISDICTION OF PAWNEE NATION DISTRICT COURT IN ALL MATTERS CONCERNING ANY
 CIVIL AND/OR CRIMINAL ISSUES THAT MAY ARISE DURING ANY GUEST'S STAY.
