RESOLUTION #21-93 NOVEMBER 9, 2021

RESOLUTION

Whereas, The Pawnee Business Council (Council) is the supreme governing body of

the Pawnee Nation and is authorized to conduct business on behalf of the Pawnee Nation in accordance with Article IV, Sections 1 and 2 of the

Pawnee Nation Constitution and By-Laws; and

Whereas, the Council met in special session on November 9, 2021, on Pawnee

Nation Microsoft TEAMS, duly authorized, with a quorum present; and

Whereas, the Council is calling for a Constitution Convention to consider revising

the Constitution of the Pawnee Nation of Oklahoma; and

Whereas, the Council's authority to manage and conduct the Convention will be

delegated to the Pawnee Nation Governing Documents Committee (Committee) to begin in January 2022 and end no later than the end of

March 2022; and

Whereas, this delegation of authority includes providing recommendations for the

appointment of convention attendees including providing for a system for

the Pawnee Membership to attend by lottery; and

Whereas, the Committee will report to the Council within forty-five days for the

appointment of the Convention attendees; and

Whereas, at the end of the Convention, the Committee will report to the Council the

results.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED the Pawnee Business Council does hereby call for the Pawnee Nation Constitution Convention that will be managed by the Pawnee Nation Governing Documents Committee, starting in January 2022 and to be completed by the end of March 2022.
