RESOLUTION

- Whereas,** The Pawnee Business Council is the supreme governing body of the Pawnee Nation and is authorized to conduct business on behalf of the Pawnee Nation in accordance with Article IV, Sections 1 and 2 of the Pawnee Nation Constitution and By-Laws; and
- Whereas,** the Pawnee Business Council met in special session on January 3, 2023, in the Pawnee Nation Roam Chief Event Center, duly authorized, with a quorum present; and
- Whereas,** the Bureau of Indian Affairs has special appropriation funds (Pawnee Annuity) available for the Pawnee Nation in the amount of \$30,000.00 for Fiscal Year 2023; and
- Whereas,** the Pawnee Nation will issue an "annuity" payment to tribal members, as authorized in the Table Creek Treaty between the Pawnee and U.S., 1857; and
- Whereas,** any disbursements will be signed by the President and the Treasurer of the Pawnee Business Council.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED the Pawnee Business Council does hereby initiate the necessary action to have the special appropriation funds transferred from the U. S. Treasury Department to the Pawnee Nation's Annuity Holding Account to the Pawnee Nation Account at the First Bank & Trust Company, 601 Harrison Street, Pawnee, Oklahoma 74058.
