RESOLUTION

- Whereas,** the Pawnee Business Council is the supreme governing body of the Pawnee Nation and is authorized to conduct business on behalf of the Pawnee Nation in accordance with Articles IV, Sections 1 and 2 of the Pawnee Nation Constitution and By-Laws; and
- Whereas,** the Pawnee Business Council met in regular session on March 21, 2023, at the Pawnee Nation Roam Chief Event Center, duly authorized, with a quorum present; and
- Whereas,** the purpose of the Self-Determination Construction Contract Number: DES-22-I-0022, in accordance with 25 C.F.R. 900.115(a) the self-determination construction contract, is a government-to-government agreement that transfers control of the construction project, including administrative functions, to the Tribe to facilitate effective and meaningful participation by the Tribe in planning, conducting, and administering the construction project, and so that the construction project is responsive to the true needs of the Indian community.
- Whereas,** the funding is an overall fair and reasonable price for the project including IHS administrative shares pursuant to 25 U.S.C. 5324(m)(4)(C) and 25 C.F.R. 900.127.
- Whereas,** the Self-Determination Construction Contract by and between the Pawnee Nation of Oklahoma and the United States Department of Health and Human Services, Indian Health Service Contract Number: DES-22-I-0022 has been reviewed and recommendations were made to the Pawnee Business Council.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED the Pawnee Business Council hereby approves the Self-Determination Construction Contract by and between the Pawnee Nation of Oklahoma and the United States Department of Health and Human Services, Indian Health Service Contract Number: DES-22-I-0022.


CERTIFICATION
