## RESOLUTION

- Whereas,** The Pawnee Business Council is the supreme governing body of the Pawnee Nation and is authorized to conduct business on behalf of the Pawnee Nation in accordance with Article IV, Sections 1 and 2 of the Pawnee Nation Constitution and By-Laws; and
- Whereas,** The Pawnee Business Council met in special session on January 15, 2021, at the Pawnee Nation Building 64 Conference Room, duly authorized, with a quorum present; and
- Whereas,** the Pawnee Business Council stands firm with the National Congress of American Indians (NCAI) in condemning the events that led to the impeachment of President Donald Trump for the assault of the U.S. Capitol; and
- Whereas,** the United States Congress has voted 232 to 197 to impeach President Trump with inciting violence against the government of the United States. The Pawnee Business Council implores the United States Senate to hold President Trump accountable for his actions and recommends conviction.

**NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED** the Pawnee Business Council calls upon Senators Inhofe and Lankford vote to convict President Trump; and




## CERTIFICATION
