RESOLUTION

- Whereas,** The Pawnee Business Council is the supreme governing body of the Pawnee Nation and is authorized to conduct business on behalf of the Pawnee Nation in accordance with Article IV, Sections 1 and 2 of the Pawnee Nation Constitution and By-Laws; and
- Whereas,** The Pawnee Business Council met in special session on February 6, 2021, at the Pawnee Nation Building 64 Conference Room, duly authorized, with a quorum present; and
- Whereas,** the Pawnee Business Council supports the recommendation of the Agriculture Committee in joining the InterTribal Buffalo Council; and
- Whereas,** the Pawnee Nation believes that the history and relationship to the buffalo is a key aspect of our culture, economic sustainability, subsistence and our way of life; and
- Whereas,** the Pawnee Nation believes that membership into the InterTribal Buffalo Council will help strengthen our commitment to reestablish buffalo herds on tribal lands in a manner that promotes cultural enhancement, spiritual revitalization, ecological restoration, and economic development.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED upon the recommendation from the Agriculture Committee, the Pawnee Business Council seeks membership into the InterTribal Buffalo Council.
