## RESOLUTION

- Whereas,** The Pawnee Business Council is the supreme governing body of the Pawnee Nation and is authorized to conduct business on behalf of the Pawnee Nation in accordance with Article IV, Sections 1 and 2 of the Pawnee Nation Constitution and By-Laws; and
- Whereas,** The Pawnee Business Council met in special session on June 24, 2021, at the Pawnee Nation Ceremonial Roundhouse, duly authorized, with a quorum present; and
- Whereas,** the Budget Committee has reviewed the Certificate of Deposit at Armstrong bank to secure the BIA Agriculture Lease Number 4200254494 and recommends approval by the Pawnee Business Council;
- Whereas,** for banking purposes, the four officers of the Pawnee Business Council who are authorized to sign accounts and signature cards: Walter Echo-Hawk, President; Jordan Kanuho, Vice President; George Gardipe, Secretary; and Carol Chapman, Treasurer; and
- Whereas,** any action taken in this Resolution shall remain in effect until changed or rescinded by a majority vote of the Pawnee Business Council.
