RESOLUTION

- Whereas,** The Pawnee Business Council is the supreme governing body of the Pawnee Nation and is authorized to conduct business on behalf of the Pawnee Nation in accordance with Article IV, Sections 1 and 2 of the Pawnee Nation Constitution and By-Laws; and
- Whereas,** the Pawnee Business Council met in special session on March 5, 2024, at the Pawnee Nation Multi-Purpose Building, duly authorized, with a quorum present; and
- Whereas,** the Pawnee Business Council, based on the recommendation of the Budget Committee, recommends an appropriation from the PN American Rescue Plan Act Budget in the amount of **\$50,000.00** for the ARPA Pawnee Business Grant Program; and
- Whereas,** the Budget Committee met on March 4, 2024, to reevaluate the ARPA Pawnee Business Grant Program to recommend additional funding in the amount of \$507.15; and
- Whereas,** the amended total amount will be \$50,507.15 to the ARPA Pawnee Business Grant Program effective March 5, 2024, and all associated expenses have met the objectives of the program; and
- Whereas,** these funds should be automatically transferred to the Pawnee Nation or in the special account set up for allocation.


