- Whereas,** The Pawnee Business Council is the supreme governing body of the Pawnee Nation and is authorized to conduct business on behalf of the Pawnee Nation in accordance with Article IV, Sections 1 and 2 of the Pawnee Nation Constitution and By-Laws; and
- Whereas,** the Pawnee Business Council met in special session on December 2, 2021, at the Pawnee Nation Roam Chief Event Center, duly authorized, with a quorum present; and
- Whereas,** the Pawnee Nation Property Committee met on May 19, 2021, in a regular meeting and recommends the following building allocation for the Division of Education to re-purpose the "Pawnee Nation Multi-Purpose Center" for the "Pawnee Nation Youth Learning Center"; and
- Whereas,** the building allocation is contingent on if the project goals are met, and this allocation will expire five (5) years after the date of this resolution or is rescinded, if the project is no longer feasible.


