RESOLUTION

- Whereas,** The Pawnee Business Council is the supreme governing body of the Pawnee Nation and is authorized to conduct business on behalf of the Pawnee Nation in accordance with Article IV, Sections 1 and 2 of the Pawnee Nation Constitution and By-Laws; and
- Whereas,** The Pawnee Business Council met virtually in a special session on February 15, 2022, duly authorized, with a quorum present; and
- Whereas,** The Pawnee Nation of Oklahoma desires to apply for funds available from Indian Health Service, an agency of the Department of Health and Human Services (DHHS) to address the prevalence of domestic and sexual violence; promote community-based and culturally appropriate prevention and treatment methods; and expand the previous domestic violence prevention initiative program.
- Whereas,** The Pawnee Business Council on behalf of the Pawnee Nation of Oklahoma hereby approves the submission of the Domestic Violence Prevention grant in the amount of \$1,000,000 for five years.

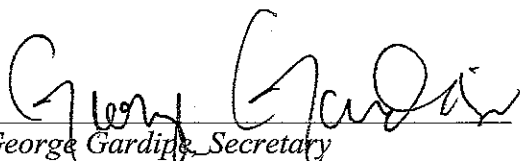
NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED the Pawnee Business Council does hereby approve the submission of the Domestic Violence Prevention grant to Indian Health Service, and further approves, adopts and readopts all items as set forth above. In addition, the following designees, including the Pawnee Business Council President, Vice-President, and Executive Director are hereby authorized to negotiate and execute the contract and any amendments thereof during the period of the grant.

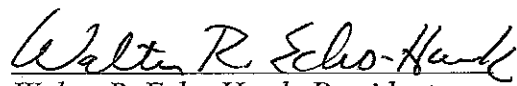
CERTIFICATION
