RESOLUTION

- Whereas,** the Pawnee Business Council is the supreme governing body of the Pawnee Nation and is authorized to conduct business on behalf of the Pawnee Nation in accordance with Article IV, Sections 1 and 2 of the Pawnee Nation Constitution and By-Laws; and
- Whereas,** the Pawnee Business Council met in virtual special session on February 15, 2022, on Pawnee Nation Microsoft TEAMS, duly authorized, with a quorum present; and
- Whereas,** the Pawnee Nation Enrollment Committee met on February 9, 2022, to review all relinquishments of tribal members and that the same was submitted to the Nasharo Council at a regular meeting held on February 12, 2022 and was documented by the Nasharo Council by Resolution #22-02 for acceptance and further review and submission to the Pawnee Business Council for final approval; and
- Whereas,** **Bernadette Rain Little Eagle Gonzales**, an enrolled member of the Pawnee Nation who has completed and submitted a signed and notarized Absolute Relinquishment requesting to relinquish her membership with the Pawnee Nation of Oklahoma and her request will be effective on the date the statement is received by the Pawnee Business Council.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, the Pawnee Business Council does hereby accept the Absolute Relinquishment of Bernadette Rain Little Eagle Gonzales from the Pawnee Nation and she will be removed permanently from the Pawnee Nation Membership Roll

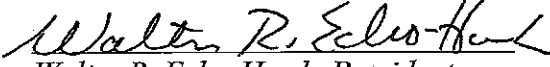
CERTIFICATION
