## RESOLUTION

- Whereas,** The Pawnee Business Council is the supreme governing body of the Pawnee Nation and is authorized to conduct business on behalf of the Pawnee Nation in accordance with Article IV, Sections 1 and 2 of the Pawnee Nation Constitution and By-Laws; and
- Whereas,** the Pawnee Business Council met in an emergency virtual session on March 7, 2022, on Pawnee Nation Microsoft TEAMS, duly authorized, with a quorum present; and
- Whereas,** the Pawnee Nation desires to deploy fiber-to-the-home in rural areas of Pawnee and Noble Counties as an Internet Service Provider (ISP); and
- Whereas,** the Pawnee Business Council Communications and IT Committee has submitted the Net Neutrality Policy for approval; and
- Whereas,** the Pawnee Business Council finds it necessary to add Section 9. Net Neutrality policy to Chapter Five (V) Electronic Communication Technology Policy of the Pawnee Nation Fiscal Policies and Procedures; and
- Whereas,** upon approval of the Net Neutrality Policy by the Pawnee Business Council this policy shall become effective on the date of approval.

**NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED** the Pawnee Business Council does hereby approve the Pawnee Nation Net Neutrality Policy which shall become effective on the date of approval by the Pawnee Business Council.
