RESOLUTION

- Whereas,** The Pawnee Business Council is the supreme governing body of the Pawnee Nation and is authorized to conduct business on behalf of the Pawnee Nation in accordance with Article IV, Sections 1 and 2 of the Pawnee Nation Constitution and By-Laws; and
- Whereas,** the Pawnee Business Council met in special session on March 10, 2022, on Microsoft TEAMS (Virtual Application), duly authorized, with a quorum present; and
- Whereas,** the Pawnee Business Council understands the harsh economic impact that the COVID-19 Pandemic has brought upon the Pawnee Nation Citizenship as this public health emergency moves into the current year; and
- Whereas,** the Pawnee Business Council recognizes that the increasing costs of food and other supplies affects one of the Nation's most vulnerable populations, our children, who are at risk of not having healthy and nutritious food during long breaks from school for lack of resources; and
- Whereas,** the Pawnee Business Council will distribute \$200.00 in assistance to all school aged children (18 years of age and younger) to help our children have access to nutritious food during their upcoming spring breaks.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED the Pawnee Business Council does hereby approve assistance in the amount of \$200.00 to all school-aged children (18 years of age and younger) to ease the challenge of providing healthy and nutritious food for our children amid increasing food costs caused by the COVID-19 Pandemic.
