RESOLUTION

- Whereas,** The Pawnee Business Council is the supreme governing body of the Pawnee Nation and is authorized to conduct business on behalf of the Pawnee Nation in accordance with Article IV, Sections 1 and 2 of the Pawnee Nation Constitution and By-Laws; and
- Whereas,** the Pawnee Business Council met in special virtual session on June 17, 2022, on Pawnee Nation Microsoft TEAMS, duly authorized, with a quorum present; and
- Whereas,** the Pawnee Business Council along with Kaw, Tonkawa, Otoe-Missouria, Ponca Nations entered into the Chilocco Treaty August 2, 2000 known as the "Chilocco Treaty Tribes" to have governmental over jointly held land and is known as "Chilocco Indian Reserve" and this governing body is known as "Council of the Confederated Chilocco Tribes"
- Whereas,** the Council of Confederated Chilocco Tribes consists of the chairs of the Pawnee, Ponca, Otoe-Missouria, Kaw, and Tonkawa. Any of the Tribes may choose to elect or appoint an alternative Councillor to the Council of Confederated Treaty Tribes to act instead of the chair; and
- Whereas,** President Echo-Hawk designates Dawna Hare, Chair of the Intergovernmental Affairs Committee and Land & Property Committee to serve on the Council of the Confederated Chilocco Treaty Tribes.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED the Pawnee Business Council does hereby designate Dawna Hare to represent the Pawnee Nation on the Council of the Confederated Treaty Tribes.

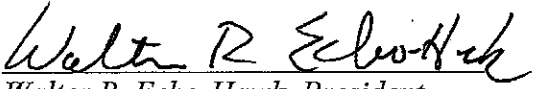
CERTIFICATION
