RESOLUTION

- Whereas,** The Pawnee Business Council is the supreme governing body of the Pawnee Nation and is authorized to conduct business on behalf of the Pawnee Nation in accordance with Article IV, Sections 1 and 2 of the Pawnee Nation Constitution and By-Laws; and
- Whereas,** the Pawnee Business Council met in special virtual session on August 23, 2022, on Pawnee Nation Microsoft TEAMS, duly authorized, with a quorum present; and
- Whereas,** the Pawnee Business Council acknowledges that it is in the best interest for the Pawnee Nation of Oklahoma to join the Nebraska Commission on Indian Affairs; and
- Whereas,** the Nebraska Commission on Indian Affairs is actively promoting state and federal legislation that is beneficial to Tribes and Indian citizens in Nebraska, which is the Pawnee Nation of Oklahoma Homeland; and
- Whereas,** the Pawnee Business Council is committee to the purpose and policies of the Nebraska Commission on Indian Affairs

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED the Pawnee Business Council does hereby approve joining the Nebraska Commission on Indian Affairs.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Pawnee Business Council designates Walter R. Echo-Hawk as the delegate and Dawna Hare as the alternate.

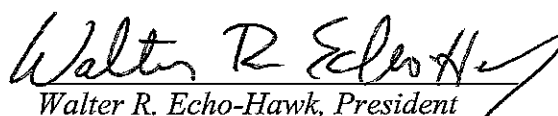
CERTIFICATION
