RESOLUTION

- Whereas,** The Pawnee Business Council is the supreme governing body of the Pawnee Nation and is authorized to conduct business on behalf of the Pawnee Nation in accordance with Article IV, Sections 1 and 2 of the Pawnee Nation Constitution and By-Laws; and
- Whereas,** the Pawnee Business Council met in special session on October 11, 2022, on Pawnee Nation Microsoft TEAMS, duly authorized, with a quorum present; and
- Whereas,** Public Law 102-477 permits the consolidation of federal funding received for employment, training, and related programs to allow greater flexibility in the development, operation, and coordination of such programs; and
- Whereas,** the desire to pursue such consolidation under Public Law 102-477 because such flexibility will allow the Pawnee Nation to better serve its members and improve the efficiency of its own operations; and
- Whereas,** the Education Division intends to integrate federal programs and funding of its choosing from the Departments of Education, Health and Human Services, Justice, Child Care Development Fund, and Labor into a single Public Law 102-477 ("477") Program; and
- Whereas,** Education Division's development and submission of a formal 477 Plan to the U.S. Department of the Interior that governs the Pawnee Nation's administration of its 477 program

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED the Pawnee Business Council does hereby approve the submission of a formal 477 Plan to the U.S. Department of the Interior.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED the following designees, including the Pawnee Business Council President and Executive Director are hereby authorized to negotiate and execute the contract and any amendments thereof during the period of the grant.

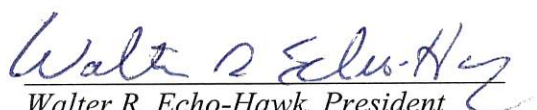
CERTIFICATION
