RESOLUTION

- Whereas,** the Pawnee Business Council is the supreme governing body of the Pawnee Nation and is authorized to conduct business on behalf of the Pawnee Nation in accordance with Article IV, Sections 1 and 2 of the Pawnee Nation Constitution and By-Laws; and
- Whereas,** the Pawnee Business Council met in Special Meeting on March 26, 2024, at the Pawnee Nation Multipurpose Building, duly authorized, with a quorum present; and
- Whereas,** the Pawnee Nation Enrollment Committee met on March 19, 2024, to review all relinquishments of tribal members and were submitted to the Nasharo Council for review; and
- Whereas,** the Nasharo Council held a special meeting on March 25, 2024 to review all relinquishments and they were documented by Nasharo Council Resolution #24-02 of their acceptance and submission to the Pawnee Business Council; and
- Whereas,** **Raven Mamie Morgan**, an enrolled Pawnee Nation member of legal age has completed and submitted a signed and notarized Conditional Relinquishment to relinquish her membership with the Pawnee Nation of Oklahoma upon acceptance of membership with the Cheyenne and Arapaho Tribes.

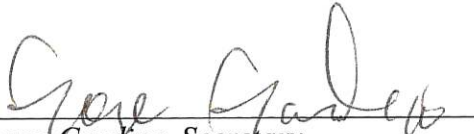
NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, the Pawnee Business Council does hereby accept the Conditional Relinquishment of Raven Mamie Morgan from the Pawnee Nation of Oklahoma and she will be removed from the Pawnee Nation Membership Roll on condition upon being accepted for membership with the Cheyenne and Arapaho Tribes.

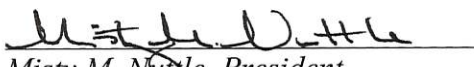
CERTIFICATION
